

Shed Application Form - *Cropwell Bishop Allotment Association*

- application form for permission to have a Shed, Greenhouse or other building on your plot

If you want to have a shed or greenhouse on your allotment plot, you must first ask for permission by completing the form below and submitting it to the Allotment Committee. Use a separate form for each building.

Whilst you should look upon this as little more than a formality, it is essential that you follow the steps below because:

- it is a condition of our lease for the allotment site,
- it should ensure that buildings do not adversely affect neighbouring plots.

To make your application, follow the steps outlined below.

Step 1 Complete the table below.

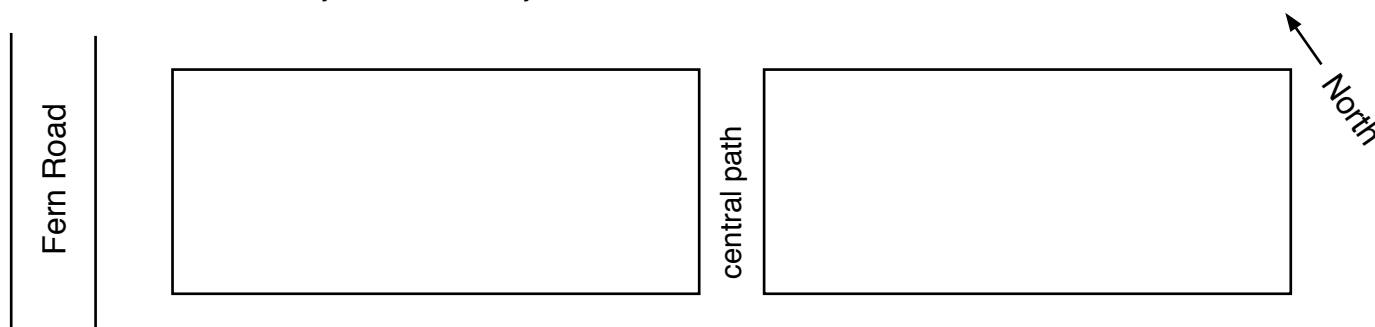

If you want to add additional notes about your building, please write on the other side of this form.

Step 2

In the drawing below, one of the plots should correspond to your own plot: use that one to draw the location of the proposed building. It only needs to be a simple hand drawn sketch and does not have to be drawn to scale but you must indicate its distance from the plot boundaries.

As a guide, the building should be at least as far away from a boundary as its height. For example, a 2.1m high shed should be at least 2.1m away from a boundary.
